Shaun Spiers has been Chief Executive of the Campaign to Protect Rural England (CPRE) since 2004. CPRE campaigns for a beautiful and living countryside. As well as a national office, CPRE has a branch in every English county, over 200 district groups and eight regional groups. It is the country's main third party participant in the planning system. Before joining CPRE Shaun was Chief Executive of the Association of British Credit Unions Limited (ABCUL) the credit union trade association. From 1994 to 1999 he was a Member of the European Parliament.
