## 2008 Travel Plan Awards go Global!

The fourth annual Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Workplace Travel Plan Awards were presented by Cllr. Pat Nash, the Mayor of Peterborough, at a ceremony on Monday (4<sup>th</sup> October 2008) this week in the Town Hall, Peterborough.

Fifteen Travel for Work employers were given a well-deserved reward for their completion of various stages of producing a workplace travel plan. The awards ranged from the 'Certificate of Commitment', where a company's senior management have agreed to put resources into the production of a travel plan, to the 'Travel Plan Excellence Award', which rewards companies with successful travel plans embedded into the culture of the organisation. The special speaker at the event was round-the-world cyclist Alastair Humphreys.
