

What this helpsheet is for

It shows you how to create a [hyperlink](#) that opens Transport Direct's journey planner with a destination of your choice already pre-set.

Instructions

Copy the following but replace the **postcode** with that of your destination:

```
http://www.transportdirect.info/web2/journeyplanning/  
jplandingpage.aspx?&id=pdf&do=p&d=BS1+5NA
```

Tip - remember to place a plus sign (+) in between the two parts of the postcode, so that the link doesn't break.

html (for website owners)

Copy the following but replace the **postcode** with that of your destination:

```
<a href=  
"http://www.transportdirect.info/web2/journeyplanning  
/jplandingpage.aspx?&id=pdf&do=p&d=BS1+5NA"  
target=_blank>Directions to the venue</a>
```

Tip - you can change the anchor text ("Directions to the venue"), which is how the link shows on your website, to anything you like.

What else is possible?

- Create a link that shows the name of your destination in Transport Direct, instead of just its postcode. (Helpsheet 1b)
- Pre-set further journey parameters - e.g. arrival time. (See **helpsheet 1d**)
- Add a mini journey planning form to your website. (See **helpsheet 2**)
- Link to a list of car parks near your destination. (See **helpsheet 4**)
